Whereas, The Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was a man who had a dream that inspired a nation;
and

Whereas, the St. Paul African Methodist Episcopal Church hosted Circleville's first Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Community Celebration; and

Whereas, the celebration of The Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day in the Pickaway County should inspire each of us to reflect on our individual contributions to the betterment of our community; and

Whereas, Dr. King stated in a sermon at the Dexter Avenue Baptist Church, "There is a great day ahead. The future is on its side. It's going now through the wilderness. But the Promised Land is ahead";
and

Whereas, we must realize the future is in our hands and together, we must dream, we must work, and we must pray to help one another and lift one another up to inspire the present and build for the future; and

Whereas, Dr. King stated in a press conference before their 1966 march in Mississippi: "This isn't any time for organizational conflicts, this isn't any time for ego battles over who's going to be the leader. We are all the leaders here ... You see, to change Mississippi we've got to be together;" and

Whereas, the people of the greater Circleville community must realize that we, too, must all be leaders and truly be together to have justice and equality for all people in our community; and

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Whereas, we must follow Dr. King's words and "rise up with a greater readiness. Let us stand with a greater determination," to make our community what it ought to be without biases based upon race, gender, color, orientation, or any other ism; and

Whereas, the Circleville Community Celebration of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day themed, "Together, You and I" serves as a reminder that it takes each of us and all of us together to build the greatest community; then

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Pickaway County Board of Commissioners does hereby proclaim the days of Sunday January 18, and Monday January 19, 2009 as

REV. DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. DAYS

in Pickaway County, Ohio and urge all citizens to honor Rev. Dr. King and his legacy by showing acceptance toward all people, promoting peace, equality, and justice, helping freedom exist everywhere for all people, and working together to build and strengthen our community and the world.
